

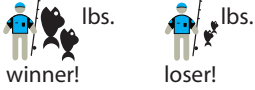
A Pennsylvania Angler's Road to the Bassmaster Classic

How do I begin?

Start at the bottom, and work your way up. You can take the state road, district road, or both to advance. Your goal is to be one of the anglers that advances.

How do I win?

At the end of the tournament, you need to have the heaviest total weight of bass.



What are points?

Points are awarded to all anglers who compete in each tournament except the state team. It's a 200 point system. The higher you place in each tournament, the more points you earn. If you attend but do not weigh in a fish, you get 50 show points. Only anglers with the highest point totals advance to the next level. You may fish and qualify in more than one district, but the points stay in the district where they were earned. You cannot accumulate points between districts or between state and districts.

12 Anglers advance as the Pennsylvania State Team

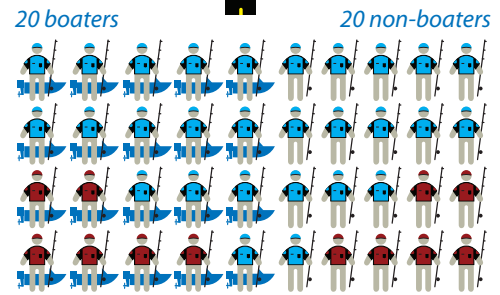
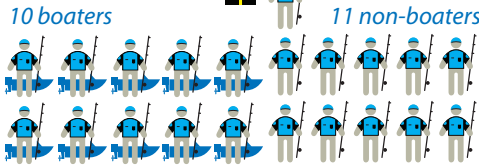
2-Day Pennsylvania State Classic

12 Anglers Advance

Represent the total anglers that advance

The number of the anglers who advance from each district is determined by a percentage of membership in each District. The number from each district can change from year to year, if membership changes.

Classic winner:
Last years classic champ gets a birth into the next years classic.



2-Day State Tournament

Club Team

Money generator for the state only.

- Club-teams compete
- Register as a team of up to six with an even number of boaters and riders
- Boaters and riders are paired in the teams boats.
- Team decides who is paired up in their boats.
